

## Environmental Policy Statement

This is the environmental policy statement for Owls Hall Environmental Ltd.

Owls Hall Environmental Ltd is a professional and environmentally conscious organisation, which acknowledges the impact that our operations may potentially have on the environment. The clear objective of Owls Hall Environmental Ltd is to minimise any impact on the environment by:
